Year in Review

The year 2025 marked a formative period in the institutional journey of the University of Kamalia. The University advanced rapidly across governance, academic development, technology infrastructure, partnerships, student support, and community engagement. The following chronology presents the year's key milestones in polished, publication-ready language.

Prof. Dr. Yasir Nawab Assumes Charge as the First Regular Vice Chancellor of the University of Kamalia

Date: 15 November 2024

On 15 November 2024, Prof. Dr. Yasir Nawab assumed office as the first regular Vice Chancellor of the University of Kamalia. At the time, the institution was largely inactive, with no functional academic operations, enrolled students, or established administrative structure.

Under his leadership, the University began a focused revival process. Administrative systems were reactivated, faculty and staff recruitment was initiated, and the foundation for academic programmes was laid.

This transition marked a defining step in restoring higher education opportunities for the region and set the direction for the University's rapid institutional growth.



Vice Chancellor Visits GCWUF to Strengthen Academic Collaboration

Date: 03 December 2024

Prof. Dr. Yasir Nawab visited Prof. Dr. Kanwal Ameen, Vice Chancellor of Government College Women University Faisalabad, to extend congratulations on her appointment and to discuss avenues for institutional cooperation.

The meeting focused on future collaboration in research, academic exchange, and joint initiatives. It reflected a shared commitment to academic excellence, knowledge exchange, and the development of meaningful inter-university partnerships.



Vice Chancellor Delivers Training Session under the NAHE-HEC Capacity-Building Programme

Date: 05 December 2024

Prof. Dr. Yasir Nawab delivered a one-day training session on leadership, policy formulation, and lifelong learning in universities as part of a five-day capacity-building programme organized by the National Academy of Higher Education, Higher Education Commission Pakistan, at Government College Women University Faisalabad.

The session emphasized effective academic leadership, sound policy development, and continuous professional growth in higher education. Participants from GCWUF, National Textile University, and Government College University Faisalabad contributed to an interactive and productive learning environment.



Vice Chancellor Awarded PAS Gold Medal 2024

Date: 07 December 2024

Prof. Dr. Yasir Nawab, Vice Chancellor of the University of Kamalia, was awarded the PAS Gold Medal 2024 by the Pakistan Academy of Sciences in recognition of his outstanding contributions to Engineering Sciences.



The distinction acknowledges his interdisciplinary research contributions and long-standing commitment to innovation, academic excellence, and impactful scholarship. The achievement was celebrated by the University community as a matter of institutional pride and inspiration for students and young researchers.

Finance and Planning Committee Reviews Key Financial Matters

Date: 20 January 2025

The 3rd meeting of the Finance and Planning Committee of the University of Kamalia was held under the chairmanship of the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Yasir Nawab.

The meeting brought together University officers, Syndicate representatives, and officials from the Higher Education Commission Pakistan, Higher Education Department Punjab, and Finance Department Punjab. The 5th Syndicate Meeting Approves Strategic and Academic Initiatives

Date: 09 April 2025

The 5th meeting of the Syndicate of the University of Kamalia was held at the Punjab Higher Education Commission, Lahore, under the chairmanship of the Minister for Higher Education Punjab. The Syndicate approved major initiatives across academic, administrative, and strategic domains, including the University's Strategic Plan 2025–2029, new academic programmes and departments, faculty and staff recruitment rules, admission criteria, adoption of HEC policies, international collaborations, and the formation of key University committees and advisory boards.



Syndicate Approves the University of Kamalia Strategic Plan 2025–2029

Date: 09 April 2025

The Syndicate approved the University of Kamalia Strategic Plan 2025–2029, providing the institution with its first comprehensive roadmap for growth, academic excellence, and regional impact. Framed around the theme “Transforming Potential into Excellence,” the Plan sets out a phased agenda for institutional development over the next five years.

The Strategic Plan outlines seven core priorities: structured growth and academic excellence, research development and innovation, smart campus and digitization, infrastructure development and campus expansion, campus quality of life, financial sustainability, and effective governance and internal efficiency. It also defines ambitious targets for academic expansion, student growth, scholarship coverage, research funding, internationalization, employability, and technology commercialization, while linking implementation to clear milestones and a monitoring and evaluation framework.



Key Governance and Policy Achievements Strengthen Institutional Framework

Date: 10 April 2025

Building on its early progress, the University achieved major milestones in governance and policy development. These included the approval and implementation of key institutional frameworks, academic regulations, and strategic policies aligned with Higher Education Commission guidelines. These measures strengthened transparency, institutional efficiency, and long-term sustainability.

University Conducts First Educational Workshop on Graphic Designing

Date: 07 July 2025




The University of Kamalia and Hizb-ur-Rahman Science College signed a Memorandum of Understanding to enhance collaboration in education, research, and student development.

Seventh Syndicate Meeting Reviews Progress and Approves Key Matters

Date: 17 July 2025

University Launches Community-Funded Scholarships for Meritorious Students

Out of 300 applicants, around 200 deserving and high-achieving students were awarded scholarships through a transparent, merit-based process. The initiative ensured that financial constraints would not prevent outstanding students from pursuing higher education.



University Conducts Selection Boards for Key Academic and Administrative Appointments

Date: 29 July 2025

The University of Kamalia conducted its Selection Board meetings to evaluate candidates for key academic and administrative positions in accordance with the approved statutory process. The exercise formed an important part of the University's institutional strengthening and recruitment drive during its foundational phase.
